

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ZORRA

BY-LAW No. 70-1978

Being a by-law to prohibit and regulate the use of land or structures for dumping or disposing of garbage, refuse, or domestic or industrial waste.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 354(1)(116) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, and amendments thereto, "... by-laws may be passed by the councils of local municipalities for prohibiting or regulating and inspecting the use of any land or structures within the municipality or any defined area or areas thereof for dumping or disposing of garbage, refuse, or domestic or industrial waste of any kind...", and

WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection (b) of Section 354(1)(116) of the said Municipal Act "... a by-law under this paragraph does not apply to the use of any land or structure by a municipality...", and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Zorra deems it expedient to prohibit and regulate the disposal and dumping of refuse within the municipality;

THEREFORE BE IT NOW AND HERewith ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:-

1. DEFINITIONS:- In this by-law -

"person" shall include a Corporation

"refuse" means garbage, domestic or industrial waste including textiles, metals, metallic compounds, timber, timber byproducts, sawdust, plastics, inks, lumber, wood fibers, rubber or rubber derivatives, oil, petroleum and petroleum byproducts, paper, chemicals, celluloid and celluloid products, resin and resin products, excelsior, cotton fibers and animal matter.

2. No land or structures within the municipality, other than those owned or used by the municipality, shall be used for the dumping or disposal of refuse;
3. The provisions of this by-law shall be deemed to apply to such land or structures within the said municipality whether or not they were used for any of the purposes aforesaid prior to the passing of this by-law;
4. Every person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offense and on summary conviction is liable to a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, exclusive of costs, and every such fine shall be recoverable under the Summary Convictions Act (Municipal Act, Sec. 466).
5. By-law No. 10-1965 of the former Township of North Oxford and any other by-law, the provisions of which are not consistent with those set forth herein, is now and hereby repealed.
6. The provisions of this by-law shall take full force and effect on the passage hereof and shall so continue in force until either amended or repealed.
7. This by-law shall be cited as the "ZORRA WASTE DISPOSAL" By-law.
